Statement by H.E. Hassan Sheikh Mohamud, President of the Federal Republic of Somalia, on the Israeli Airstrikes in Doha

Your Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, Amir of the State of Qatar

The Federal Republic of Somalia expresses its deep shock and strongest condemnation of the Israeli airstrikes carried out on September 9th against a peaceful residential area in Doha, the capital of the brotherly State of Qatar. This act is a blatant violation of international law, Qatar's sovereignty, and territorial integrity. Moreover, it is a grave threat to regional security, peace, and stability.

Your Highness, the Somali government and people extend their deepest condolences to His Highness Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani, Emir of the State of Qatar, and through him the Government, and the brotherly people of Qatar, for the tragic loss of innocent lives.

We pray for the swift recovery of those injured and reaffirm Somalia's unwavering solidarity with our Qatari brothers and sisters during this defining moment in their history.

All and any unlawful aggression not only disregard human life but also contravenes the fundamental principles of international law, particularly the United Nations Charter which prohibits the use of force against the territorial integrity and political independence of sovereign states.

Somalia stands firmly with Qatar in its right to defend its sovereignty and security. We call upon all the international community, most urgently the United Nations Security Council to fulfill its mandate in upholding international peace and security. Silence or inaction in the face of such aggression would set a dangerous precedent and erode the already weakening rules-based international order.

This reckless escalation comes at a time when the world urgently needs diplomacy, restraint, and renewed commitment to dialogue and political settlements. The indispensable role of Qatar as a mediator in advancing global peace efforts in general and in particular the current fiasco in Gaza must be recognized and supported, not undermined through acts of hostility.

Today the reality in GAZA is a global shame which no one ever be proud of. Israel must remember its own history that teaches clearly no nation can eternally wiped from the face of the globe. Hence, palastine will defnitely prevail.

The Federal Republic of Somalia reiterates its support for an immediate and unconditional ceasefire in Gaza, the release of all detained hostages, and the unhindered delivery of humanitarian aid to those suffering under the devastating conditions in Gaza.

We stress, again, that durable peace in the Middle East requires addressing the root causes of the instability, in full conformity with international law and justice.

In conclusion, Somalia will continue to stand in solidarity with Qatar's path to pursue global peace, specially that of Gaza beacuse it is the only way that alleviates the suffering of innocent people.

Somalia will remain to stand shoulder to shoulder with all those who seek peace, justice, and stability across the world.
